

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




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### COMPANY OVERVIEW





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### HIGHLIGHTS OF 1Q2023

TSE have been awarded as renewable energy power producers and supplier to Thai Government according to the notification of ERC from renewable energy sources under the Feed-in Tariff (FiT) scheme 2022-2030 for the power plants with no fuel costs B.E. 2565 (2022) for 7 projects with total Installed Capacity of 128.89 MW and total Selling Capacity of 88.66 MW.





### **REVENUE AND EBITDA 1Q2023**




#### TOTAL REVENUE AND SHARE OF PROFIT FROM JV +9%

Total revenue and Share of profit from JV in 1Q2023 were increased to 561 MB or+9% compared to 1Q2022 of 515 MB. Even though, the group's revenue in this quarter was decreased from divestment in solar farms in Japan in 1Q2022, but there were revenue from acquisition of new Solar farm named SOILCRETE which starting revenue and profit recognition since Q2/2022 onward including the announcement of ERC to increase the Fuel Adjustment Charge (Ft).

EBITDA (3M) 1Q2023




EBITDA in 1Q2023 was increased to 407 MB or +47% compared to 1Q2022 of 276 MB (exclude extraordinary gain). This was due to the Company has increased in revenue from new solar farm, the Fuel Adjustment Charge (Ft) and decrease in COGS as previously explained.




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
### D/E RATIO AND ROE




#### D/E\* RATIO



Increasing from 6,443 MB. to 6,560 MB. or +1.8%

In 1Q2023, overall operating performance (exclude extraordinary profit) was increased as compared to 1Q2022 mainly due to increase in new project PV farm, the Fuel Adjustment Charge (Ft) resulting in grew up in revenue and also continuously efficient management of operating costs including administration expenses resulted in lower expenses and higher bottom-line number.

### **DEBT STRUCTURE 1Q2023**



Most of interest bearing debt from Project Finance Loan for 58%, increased from Onikoube Project Finance Loan drawdown. 14% of Project Finance Loan from COD projects decreased accordingly from schedule repayment.

The remaining interest bearing debt from Corporate Loan and Debenture for 42% decreased from schedule repayment.



#### CAPACITY GROWTH FORECAST






